Enduro Sprint Final 2011

Another solid weekend for the KORR team at the final round of the Sprint Enduro championship, 2 days of great weather and probably the best circuit of the series, a track combining every type of natural off-road obstacle that you can find on a Welsh Hill farm plus some added man made Extreme sections and a MX circuit.

Day 1 and fresh from his success in Erzberg the week before Jonny Walker showed he is really coming to form, he blitzed the under 23 class with a win of more than 90 seconds and he also finished 2nd overall amongst the Elite riders and won 3 tests outright !!!.

Our Elite class riders could not match the pace of young Jonny but still put in solid results, Greg finished 2nd in the Elite class behind local favourite Tom Sagar and Daryl Bolter finished 4th aboard his 250 XCF. The second day Greg dropped to 3rd in class and Daryl who had been in 3rd position for most of the day until a mistake, dropped him to 4th again.

Jonny on the second day was leading again but now his fellow competitors were much closer after gaining familiarity with the circuit, on the 3rd lap whilst pushing hard he made a small crash over some logs, the bike landed on him and pinned him down with the motor still revving and the rear tyre spinning, cutting through his shirt and a layer of skin, even his helmet had rubber tyre marks on it !!. he needed assistance to remove the bike from him and amazingly he remounted his very twisted KTM, which now had a broken throttle and the front fender hanging off to complete the lap and only lost 1 minute, but with such close racing on day 2 he could not make further progress than 4th position despite once again setting fastest times near the end of the day.
