

Sprint Enduro – Rogers Hill Raceway, Dorset

Rounds 5 & 6 visited Rogers Hills Raceway in Dorset, a roughly 10 minute course comprising of open farmland, a large Motocross circuit and some extreme obstacles, giving a good variation with an interesting course offering great viewing for the spectators and teams alike.

Greg Evans 350 XCF started well with an opening test time in 2nd position behind David Knight but his weekend would to a premature end when on the 4th test he damaged his knee and had to withdraw from competition.

Daryl Bolter 250 XCF did not in his opinion have the best of days and struggled with severe arm pump and later in the day crashed which cost him 4th position, however he still finished again as the fastest 250F. On Sunday Daryl found what he was missing from day 1 and the reversed course suited him better, in a close battle all day with Tom Sagar 450KTM he finished 3rd overall in the Elite class.

Jonny Walker 300 EXC had another great and promising weekend showing great speed and progress showing the former trials riders is quickly learning to mix it with the more experienced MX and Enduro riders. Racing in the Under 23 class Jonny held 2nd position for most of Saturday and eventually finished the day in 3rd position and 6th overall amongst Elite riders. Sunday was a repeat performance of day 1 with Jonny taking another 3rd in class.

Julian Stevens Team Manager “After strong performances here last year we were optimistic about strong results this weekend, with Greg making a mistake and not finishing both days that has made it difficult for him to challenge for the championship, now that David Knight will miss the next 2 rounds as he is needing an operation the championship is open, I was hoping that either Greg or Daryl could take up the fight. Daryl struggled with arm pump on Saturday and could not push at the speed he wanted but he did a great job on Sunday to take a very strong 3rd position. Jonny again continues to impress with his efforts and ability to quickly learn, the results of the front running Under 23 riders show there is great talent coming through and that the established Elite riders should be concerned, very concerned !!”.
